-Online donation methods – Allison reported on her research on donation methods

- PayPal for business:
  - PayPal offers discounted transaction rates for 501(c)(3) for most products, and consistently low rates for all other nonprofits. No extra fees for setup, statements, withdrawals or cancellation.
  - 2.2% + \$0.30 per transaction and no monthly fee.
- Razoo:
  - **4.9%** Platform Fee, **2.0%** + **30¢** Payment Fee
- Just Give:
  - No set-up or monthly fees
  - 4.5% transaction fee
- Network for good:
  - Minimum \$59 annual fee
  - 3% processing fee
