# DA-HOW Fourth Step Close Study

All readings are from <u>The Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous</u> (the 12&12) or <u>Alcoholics Anonymous</u> (the Big Book).

# 1. *Reading:* Pages 42-47 in the 12&12

**Writing:** Discuss and reflect on the following quotation found on page 47: "We thought conditions drove us to drink" reflecting on the people, places, conditions and circumstances in your life that drove you to debt, spend or otherwise abuse money.

## 2. *Reading:* Pages 48-49 in the 12&12

**Writing:** Discuss and reflect on the following quotations found on page 49: "These fears are the termites that ceaselessly devour the foundations of whatever sort of life we try to build."

## 3. *Reading:* Pages 50-51 in the 12&12

Writing: Discuss and reflect on the following quotation found on page 50: "By now the newcomer has probably arrived at the following conclusions... (continue through)...that all the faulty foundation of his life will have to be torn out and built anew on bedrock."

# 4. *Rea∂ing:* Pages 50-53 in the 12&12

*Writing:* Discuss and reflect on the following quotation found on page 53: "The primary fact that we fail to recognize is our total inability to form a true partnership with another human being."

## 5. *Reading:* Pages 53 in the 12&12

**Writing:** Discuss and reflect on the following quotation found on page 53: "This self centered behavior blocked a partnership relation with any one of those about us. Of true brotherhood we had small comprehension."

## 6. *Reading:* Pages 53-54 in the 12&12

*Writing:* Discuss and reflect on the following quotation found on page 53: "Because our surface record hasn't looked too bad... (continue through)...Whatever the defects, they have finally ambushed us into alcoholism and misery."

## 7. **Reading:** Pages 63-64 in the Big Book

**Writing:** Discuss and reflect on the following quotation found on page 64: "Next we launched out on a course of vigorous action, the first step of which is a personal housecleaning, which many of us had never attempted."

## 8. *Reading:* Pages 64 in the Big Book

*Writing:* Discuss and reflect on the following quotations found on page 64: "Our liquor was but a symptom. So we had to get down to causes and conditions."

9. *Reading:* Pages 64 in the Big Book *Writing:* Discuss and reflect on the following quotations found on page 64: "When the spiritual malady is overcome, we straighten out mentally and physically."
